Summary (as of May 11, 2021)

Defund Cities that Defund the Police Act of 2021

This bill prohibits state or local governments that abolish or defund police departments from receiving certain Economic Development Administration grants or Community Development Block Grant funds.

Specifically, the bill applies to state or local governments that abolish or disband the police or significantly reduce the police department's budget without reallocating a portion of those funds to any other community policing program.

Further, a state or local government that abolishes or defunds a police department must return any Community Development Block Grant funds it has already received.

Actions Timeline

- **May 12, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **May 11, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 11, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
