Protect Utah's Rural Economy Act

This bill prohibits the President from establishing or extending national monuments in Utah unless

- the proposed establishment or extension has been authorized by federal statute, and
- the President has received a notice from the Governor of Utah that the state legislature has enacted legislation approving of the proposed establishment or extension.

- **Jan 22, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **Jan 22, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
