Lake Tahoe Restoration Reauthorization Act

This bill reauthorizes through September 30, 2034, activities to restore Lake Tahoe and its surrounding basin. Lake Tahoe is a large freshwater lake on the border of California and Nevada.

- **May 13, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **May 12, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 12, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
