### Summary (as of May 12, 2021)

#### Disaster Relief Transparency Act

This bill requires the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Federal Emergency Management Agency to report on the allocation and applicant approval rates of specified assistance programs related to disaster recovery.

## Actions Timeline

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- **May 13, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **May 12, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 12, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
