Summary (as of May 13, 2021)

Shawnee Wilderness Designation Act

This bill designates approximately 289,000 acres of Forest Service land comprising the Shawnee National Forest in Illinois as the Shawnee Wilderness and as a component of the National Wilderness Preservation System.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 1, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jun 29, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **May 13, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 13, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
