### Summary (as of May 13, 2021)

#### Joint Chiefs Landscape Restoration Partnership Act of 2021

This bill directs the Department of Agriculture (USDA) to establish a Joint Chiefs Landscape Restoration Partnership program to improve the health and resilience of forest landscapes across National Forest System lands and state, tribal, and private lands. Activities under the program may include reducing the risk of wildfire, protecting water quality and supply, or improving wildlife habitat for at-risk species.

## Actions Timeline

- **Jul 1, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jun 24, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **May 13, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 13, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
