Summary (as of May 13, 2021)

Restore Employment in Natural and Environmental Work Conservation Corps Act or the RENEW Conservation Corps Act

This bill establishes the Restore Employment in Natural and Environmental Work Conservation Corps program within the Department of the Interior and Department of Agriculture under which participants must implement eligible projects (e.g., planting trees or controlling invasive species).

- **May 14, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment.
- **May 14, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **May 13, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 13, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Agriculture, Energy and Commerce, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
