Summary (as of Oct 18, 2022)

Wilson's Creek National Battlefield Boundary Revision Act of 2021

This bill extends the boundary of the Wilson's Creek National Battlefield in Missouri to include approximately 25 acres of land related to the Newtonia Battlefield identified on the map titled *Wilson's Creek National Battlefield Proposed Boundary Modification* and dated July 2022.

The Department of the Interior may acquire such land by donation, purchase from willing sellers with donated or appropriated funds, or exchange.

Actions Timeline

- **Oct 18, 2022:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Reported by Senator Manchin under authority of the order of the Senate of 10/14/2022 with amendments. With written report No. 117-185.
- **Oct 18, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 536.
- **Jul 21, 2022:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources. Ordered to be reported with amendments favorably.
- **May 11, 2022:** Committee on Energy and Natural Resources Subcommittee on National Parks. Hearings held.
- **Dec 2, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **Dec 2, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources.
