Summary (as of Jan 11, 2022)

Bear Poaching Elimination Act of 2022

This bill makes it unlawful for a person to knowingly import, export, sell, purchase, possess, transport, deliver, or receive bear viscera or related products except for limited acts carried out solely to enforce wildlife protection laws.
