Summary (as of May 25, 2021)

Railroad Yardmaster Protection Act of 2021

This bill applies to yardmaster employees the limitations on duty hours and the restrictions on communications to employees during their off-duty hours that are currently applicable to train employees. A *yardmaster employee* means an individual responsible for supervising and coordinating the control of trains and engines operating within a rail yard.

- **May 25, 2021:** Referred to the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
