This bill directs the Forest Service to, no less than once every 5 years, complete a wildfire assessment that includes analysis of, among other things, with respect to the previous five years

- the direct costs of wildfire response, preparation, and recovery, including wildfire mitigation and wildlife suppression activities and human health;
- the indirect costs of wildfire response, preparation, and recovery, including diminished tax revenue and lost business revenue, including supply chain impacts; and
- whether the direct and indirect costs have been or will be paid by the federal government, state or territory governments, or county or local governments.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 7, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Conservation and Forestry.
- **Jul 5, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **May 25, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 25, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
