Summary (as of May 28, 2021)

Affordable Solar Energy for Our Communities Act

This bill directs the Department of Energy to establish a program to provide financial assistance, such as grants or low-interest loans, to certain entities for the planning or installation of solar facilities that benefit certain low-income households.
