Summary (as of May 28, 2021)

Blockchain Promotion Act of 2021

This bill directs the Department of Commerce to establish the Blockchain Working Group to submit a report to Congress that contains a recommended definition of the distributed ledger technology commonly referred to as blockchain technology and other specified recommendations regarding this technology.

Actions Timeline

- **May 31, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Consumer Protection and Commerce.
- **May 28, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 28, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
