### Summary (as of Jun 11, 2021)

#### Locality-based Social Security Benefits Act of 2021

This bill directs the Social Security Administration to increase an individual's monthly Social Security benefit amount in accordance with the locality-based comparability payment rate applicable to the federal locality-pay area in which the individual resides.
