Clean Energy Victory Bond Act of 2021

This bill directs the Department of the Treasury to issue Clean Energy Victory Bonds for investment in clean energy projects at the federal, state, and local level.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
