## Summary (as of Jun 15, 2021)

### National Ocean and Coastal Security Improvements Act of 2021

This bill funds through FY2030 and expands the National Ocean and Coastal Security Fund. The fund must be used by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation to award grants for protecting, conserving, restoring, and using ocean, coastal, or Great Lakes resources, including coastal infrastructure.

- **Jun 15, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 15, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment.
