Summary (as of Jun 16, 2021)

Modernizing Financing of Early Care and Education in America Act of 2021

This bill establishes the Bipartisan Commission on Early Childhood Education Financing to submit recommendations to Congress on how to modernize federal financing of early care and education programs to streamline and reduce duplicate funding streams.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 16, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 16, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Education and Labor, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 16, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Worker and Family Support.
