Summary (as of Jun 17, 2021)

Fairness in Firearm Testing Act

This bill establishes additional requirements for the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF).

Specifically, the bill requires the ATF to make a video recording of its process for evaluating and testing an item to determine if it is a firearm or ammunition.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism, and Homeland Security.
- **Jun 17, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 17, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on the Judiciary, and in addition to the Committee on Ways and Means, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
