Summary (as of May 17, 2021)

This resolution supports the goals and ideals of an International Day Against Homophobia, Transphobia, and Biphobia.

The resolution encourages (1) health care providers to offer culturally and clinically competent care to the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, or questioning (LGBTQ+) community; (2) schools to support the creation of gender and sexuality alliances; (3) individuals to learn about national resources for those who identify as LGBTQ+; and (4) funding organizations, aid efforts, and governments to prioritize the health and human rights of LGBTQ+ people.

Actions Timeline

- **May 18, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **May 17, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **May 17, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Education and Labor, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
