Summary (as of Jun 23, 2021)

Addressing Social Determinants in Medicare Advantage Act of 2021

This bill allows Medicare Advantage plans to offer certain supplemental benefits that are currently only available to chronically ill enrollees to enrollees with low-income or who meet other criteria, such as socioeconomic risk factors.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 24, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 23, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 23, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Jun 23, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
