Wildland Fire Mitigation and Management Commission Act of 2021

This bill directs the Departments of the Interior and Agriculture and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to jointly establish a commission to study and make recommendations to improve federal policies relating to wildland fire prevention, mitigation, suppression, management, and rehabilitation.

The Department of Defense and other relevant federal departments and agencies must submit to the commission an inventory of surplus cargo and passenger aircraft and excess common-use aircraft parts that may be used for wildland firefighting purposes.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 23, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests, and Public Lands.
- **Jun 24, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Jun 23, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 23, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, Armed Services, and Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
