Summary (as of Jun 24, 2021)

National Biomedical Research Act

This bill establishes and makes deposits through FY2031 into the Biomedical Innovation Fund for initiatives at the National Institutes of Health and the Food and Drug Administration. The fund supports (1) research for disease prevention, diagnosis, and treatment; (2) research for diseases that disproportionately account for federal health care spending; (3) the development, review, and post-market surveillance of medical products; and (4) other innovative medical research.

Actions Timeline

- **Jun 25, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jun 24, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 24, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Rules, and the Budget, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
