Summary (as of Jun 30, 2021)

Pipeline Seismic Safety Study Act

This bill requires the Department of Transportation (DOT) to contract with the National Academy of Sciences for a study evaluating federal requirements for pipeline facilities concerning seismicity, erosion, and other dynamic geological conditions. DOT must consult with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on the study.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 1, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Highways and Transit.
- **Jun 30, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jun 30, 2021:** Sponsor introductory remarks on measure. (CR E727)
- **Jun 30, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
