## **Dairy Pricing and Policy Commission Act of 2021**

This bill directs the Department of Agriculture (USDA) to temporarily establish the Dairy Pricing and Policy Commission.

The commission shall develop legislative, regulatory, and market-based recommendations to

- improve milk prices and dairy farm profitability, including for responding to periods of heightened dairy production during low prices;
- enhance competitiveness of American dairy in world markets; and
- evaluate new markets for dairy exports.

The commission shall terminate on the earlier of (1) the date it submits to USDA and Congress a report of its legislative and regulatory recommendations; or (2) the date that is two years after the commission's establishment.
