Garrett Lee Smith Memorial Reauthorization Act of 2022

This bill reauthorizes through FY2027 multiple suicide prevention programs and related activities with a particular focus on youth and young adults.

Specifically, the bill reauthorizes

- grants for statewide or tribal youth suicide prevention and early intervention strategies and for mental health and substance use disorder services for college students, and
- a suicide prevention resource center that provides training and other resources regarding suicide prevention among all ages.
