Summary (as of May 26, 2022)

Informing Veterans on Education for Transitioning Servicemembers Act of 2022 or the Informing VETS Act of 2022

This bill requires the Department of Veterans Affairs to regularly promote the Veteran Readiness and Employment program by (1) sending a letter to each veteran entitled to the program that explains the educational benefits of the program, and (2) providing in each letter and online a side-by-side comparison of benefits between the program and Post-9/11 GI Bill educational assistance.

- **May 26, 2022:** Introduced in Senate
- **May 26, 2022:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs.
