Holding SSA Employees Accountable Act

This bill prohibits employees of the Social Security Administration who are convicted of certain offenses related to their official duties from further participating in federal annuity programs.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 9, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 9, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
