## **Artificial Intelligence for Agency Impact Act or the AI for Agency Impact Act**

This bill requires each federal agency to establish and implement an artificial intelligence (AI) strategy, objectives, and metrics plan.

Each plan shall include

- defined roles, responsibilities, and delegation of authority for AI use and oversight;
- defined values, ethics, and principles to foster public trust and responsible use of AI;
- procedures to ensure data security and privacy and for human supervision and accountability;
- performance objectives and accompanying metrics that clearly reflect or convey the intended purpose of the AI;
- documentation demonstrating that the AI relies on high quality, reliable, representative data;
- a description of how the AI is monitored; and
- a description of how information on the design, operation, limitations, and updates of the AI is made available to the public.
