Summary (as of Jan 25, 2021)

Building United States Infrastructure and Leveraging Development Act or the BUILD Act

This bill increases from \$15 billion to \$30 billion the national limitation on the amount of tax-exempt highway or surface freight transfer facility bonds.

The bill also applies the prevailing wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act to projects funded by bond issues.
