This bill expands exemptions from environmental review requirements for projects of the Forest Service concerning wildfire resilience or insects and disease.

Actions Timeline

- **Jul 19, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Agriculture, and in addition to the Committee on Natural Resources, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
