Summary (as of Sep 12, 2022)

Members of Congress Pension Opt Out Clarification Act

This bill allows future Members of the House of Representatives to opt out of the Federal Employees Retirement System, an option currently available to Members of the House who began serving before September 30, 2003, and all Senators. In addition, it permits Members of Congress who opt out to continue to participate in the Thrift Savings Plan.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 17, 2022:** Star Print ordered on the reported bill.
- **Sep 12, 2022:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Reported by Senator Carper for Senator Peters with amendments. With written report No. 117-143.
- **Sep 12, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 481.
- **May 25, 2022:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Feb 25, 2021:** Introduced in Senate
- **Feb 25, 2021:** Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
