Summary (as of Jul 27, 2021)

Desalination Development Act

This bill reauthorizes through FY2024 a grant program for constructing desalination projects. The bill also revises the program, including by requiring the prioritization of projects that maximize energy efficiency and the use of renewable energy.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife.
- **Jul 27, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 27, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
