Summary (as of Dec 13, 2022)

Trusted Traveler Reconsideration and Restoration Act of 2021

This bill directs (1) the Government Accountability Office to review Department of Homeland Security (DHS) trusted traveler programs, and (2) DHS to extend the enrollment period where an individual's participation in a trusted traveler program was revoked in error.

- **Dec 13, 2022:** Placed on Senate Legislative Calendar under General Orders. Calendar No. 637.
- **Jul 14, 2021:** Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs. Ordered to be reported without amendment favorably.
- **Apr 20, 2021:** Received in the Senate and Read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs.
- **Apr 19, 2021:** Mr. Torres (NY) moved to suspend the rules and pass the bill.
- **Apr 19, 2021:** Considered under suspension of the rules. (consideration: CR H1898-1899)
- **Apr 19, 2021:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with forty minutes of debate on H.R. 473.
