- **Jun 14, 2021:** DEBATE - The House proceeded with one hour of debate on H. Res. 473.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** The House Committee on Rules reported an original measure, H. Rept. 117-59, by Mr. McGovern.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** Resolution provides for consideration of H.R. 256 under a closed rule and provides for consideration of H.R. 1187 under a structured rule. The resolution provides for one hour of debate for each bill and for one motion to recommit for each bill. The resolution provides that H. Res. 467 is adopted.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** Placed on the House Calendar, Calendar No. 19.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** POSTPONED PROCEEDINGS - At the conclusion of debate on H. Res. 473, the Chair put the question on ordering the previous question and by voice vote, announced that the yeas had prevailed. Mr. Reschenthaler demanded the yeas and nays and the Chair postponed further proceedings on ordering the previous question until a time to be announced.
- **Jun 14, 2021:** Considered as unfinished business. (consideration: CR H2723-2724)
- **Jun 14, 2021:** On ordering the previous question Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 217 - 203 (Roll no. 157).
- **Jun 14, 2021:** Passed/agreed to in House: On agreeing to the resolution Agreed to by the Yeas and Nays: 216 - 206 (Roll no. 158).
