Summary (as of Aug 4, 2022)

Improving Marine Highway Transportation Act of 2022

This bill modifies the definition of *marine highway transportation* to include the carriage by a documented vessel of cargo that is bulk, liquid, or loose cargo loaded in tanks, holds, hoppers, or on deck.
