#### Community Wildfire Protection Act of 2022

This bill modifies the definition of *at-risk community* with respect to the hazardous fuel reduction program to eliminate the requirement that such a community be an interface community as defined in the notice titled *Wildland Urban Interface Communities Within the Vicinity of Federal Lands That Are at High Risk From Wildfire* or be within or adjacent to federal land.
