## **Project Safe Neighborhoods Reauthorization Act of 2022**

This bill reauthorizes through FY2026 the Project Safe Neighborhoods Block Grant Program within the Department of Justice. The bill also allows funds under the program to be used for

- hiring crime analysts to assist with violent crime reduction efforts;
- the cost of overtime for law enforcement officers, prosecutors, and law enforcement assistants who assist with the program;
- purchasing, implementing, and using technology to assist with violent crime reduction efforts; and
- supporting multijurisdictional task forces.
