Summary (as of Jul 30, 2021)

Reducing Unnecessary Senior Hospitalizations Act of 2021 or the RUSH Act of 2021

This bill establishes a program through which qualified group practices may provide certain items and services that are normally provided at hospital emergency departments to individuals who (1) are entitled to Medicare hospital services, (2) are enrolled for Medicare medical services, and (3) reside in qualified skilled nursing facilities.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 2, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Jul 30, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 30, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
