Summary (as of Jul 30, 2021)

Improving Diaper Affordability Act of 2021

This bill treats diapers as qualified medical expenses for purposes of certain health savings accounts and spending arrangements.

The bill prohibits a state or local government from imposing a sales tax on the retail sale of diapers.

Actions Timeline

- **Nov 1, 2022:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Antitrust, Commercial, and Administrative Law.
- **Jul 30, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Jul 30, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on the Judiciary, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
