Summary (as of Aug 3, 2021)

Medicare Advantage Quality Payment Relief Act of 2021

This bill requires the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services to disregard the application of certain percentage quality increases when calculating the maximum payment that may be made to a Medicare Advantage organization.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 4, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
- **Aug 3, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 3, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Aug 3, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Health.
