### Summary (as of Sep 22, 2022)

#### Youth Coastal Fishing Program Act of 2022

This bill directs the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) to establish a program to award grants and provide technical assistance to certain entities for youth fishing projects.

In awarding grants, NOAA must prioritize applicants with proposals for youth fishing projects that focus on an underserved community.
