Summary (as of Sep 27, 2022)

This bill requires the Department of the Army to establish sex-neutral fitness standards for combat Military Occupational Specialties (MOSSs) that are higher than those for non-combat MOSSs and brief Congress on the established combat MOSSs and the methodology for determining such MOSSs.
