Summary (as of Aug 6, 2021)

Preserving Existing Nuclear Energy Generation Act

This bill requires the Department of Energy to establish (1) a program to evaluate nuclear reactors that are projected to cease operations due to economic factors and to allocate financial credits to certain reactors, and (2) a grant program to assist communities with revenue shortfalls due to closures of nuclear power plants.

## Actions Timeline

- **Aug 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Aug 9, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Energy.
- **Aug 6, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 6, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on Transportation and Infrastructure, and Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
