Summary (as of Aug 10, 2021)

Passenger Rail Preclearance Implementation Act of 2021

This bill directs the Department of Homeland Security to implement a process for preclearance screening of passengers and baggage on rail service between the United States and Canada. The bill also reauthorizes through FY2026 funding for rail improvement grants and permits the Department of Transportation to expend a specified amount of that funding on the preclearance process.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 11, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Railroads, Pipelines, and Hazardous Materials.
- **Aug 11, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Border Security, Facilitation, and Operations.
- **Aug 10, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Aug 10, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committees on Ways and Means, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
- **Aug 10, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Trade.
