Summary (as of Mar 1, 2021)

More Access to ZEV Equipment in Transit Act or the MAZE in Transit Act

This bill modifies the definition of *capital project* to make zero-emission vehicle fueling technology projects eligible for federal funding. A *zero-emission vehicle* is defined as a low or no emission vehicle that produces no carbon or particulate matter.
