This bill directs the Commodity Futures Trading Commission to report on virtual currency markets and U.S. competitiveness.

Actions Timeline

- **Aug 24, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Financial Services, and in addition to the Committee on Agriculture, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
