CISA Leadership Act

This bill establishes a term limit and specifies the appointment process for the Director of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) of the Department of Homeland Security.

Specifically, the bill establishes a five-year term for the director of CISA.

The director shall be appointed by the President, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 8, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Communications and Technology.
- **Sep 8, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Infrastructure Protection, and Innovation.
- **Sep 7, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 7, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Homeland Security, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, and Oversight and Reform, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
