Just Transition for Energy Communities Act

This bill establishes a program to assist eligible states and tribal governments that are economically reliant on fossil fuel development, production, or electricity generation to diversify their economies.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 8, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Economic Development, Public Buildings, and Emergency Management.
- **Sep 7, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 7, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure, and in addition to the Committee on Financial Services, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
