## Summary (as of Dec 8, 2022)

### Restaurant Revitalization Tax Credit Act

This bill allows certain restaurants affected by the COVID-19 pandemic a credit against payroll tax liability up to 100% of the wages paid to their employees, not to exceed \$25,000 in any calendar quarter.
