Rewarding Efforts to Decrease Unrecycled Contaminants in Ecosystems Act of 2021 or the REDUCE Act of 2021

This bill imposes an excise tax on any taxable virgin plastic resin.

The bill establishes a Plastic Waste Reduction Fund to carry out reduction and recycling activities, plastic waste and marine debris reduction, detection, monitoring, and cleanup activities, and address environmental justice and pollution impacts from plastic products.

Actions Timeline

- **Sep 28, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Coast Guard and Maritime Transportation.
- **Sep 28, 2021:** Referred to the Subcommittee on Environment and Climate Change.
- **Sep 27, 2021:** Introduced in House
- **Sep 27, 2021:** Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committees on Energy and Commerce, Natural Resources, and Transportation and Infrastructure, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.
